

The Story of our Choir

This is a super-simple, uplifting round to finish off your pre-performance warm-up and send everyone onto the stage feeling great and raring to go!

It sounds best at an upbeat tempo of around crotchet (quarter note) = 110. The key shown below works well for mixed voices, but you can transpose it if you have a choir with a higher or lower range.
